There will be absolutely no walk in entries allowed - participants MUST be pre-signed up and PAID

Open Level I: Night Shotz (3329 N. Garfield, Loveland) **Start Time: 1:00 PM**

Race to 3, (501, cricket, 501, cricket, choice) Average of 25.00 to no limit (Night Shotz doors open at 11 am)

Open Level II: Emporium Clubhouse (1345 Water Valley Pkwy, Windsor) **Start Time: 1:00 PM**

Race to 3 —(501, cricket, 501, cricket, choice) Average of 20.50 to 24.99 (Clubhouse doors open at noon)

Open Level III: East End Ale House (422 E. 4th St., Loveland) **Start Time: 1:00 PM**

Race to 2 —(501, cricket, choice) Average of 0.00 to 20.49 (East End doors open at 10 AM)

Women's Average of 0.00 to 19.99: **Pitchers** (1100 W. Drake Rd., Ft. Collins) **Start Time: NOON**

Race to 2—(501, cricket, choice) Females ONLY (Pitchers doors open at 11 AM)

Women above 19.99 play in appropriate Open Level

Entry Fee \$15 - Double Elimination
100% payback + ADDED \$1800
(The final 3 in each level will receive t-shirts)

Rules: To qualify for 2026 BMW Most Improved Players tournament, must have been “most improved player of week”, paid sanction & regular weekly fees and played 80% of the BMW 2025-2026 fall/winter league season. TOC leagues do NOT count toward qualifications.

Mon Master league - BMW players that played over 80% (have not been player of week) will qualify for Level I. (If in Masters and have been player of week & played 80%, will be placed into appropriate level by average.) See list for names of MIP qualified players. (Please note: List is everyone who has been most improved player of week. Must still played 80% of league season to qualify for tournament.)

Flip to start to decide who will be first, thereafter losers will start all games. Tie-breaker—flip & diddle, winner of diddle can choose game (01 or cricket) or choose to go first.

Average will be a combined PPD & MPR value. To calculate combined PPD/ MPR, take MPR and multiply by 10 then add PPD & MPR together then divide by 2. If playing in multiple leagues take your highest PPD & MPR with over 24 games played to calculate average.
